- *Nevada Certification Board charges \$75 to become certificated as a CHW 1 after students complete this course*

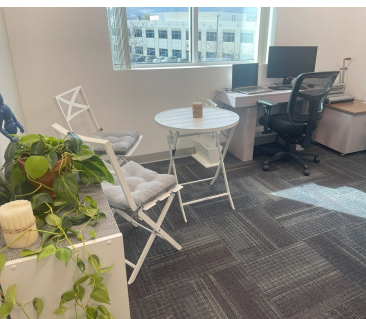
